the complexities and contradictions produced by the voting rights law while at the same time calling for the federal judiciary to exercise restraint in imposing its will when it lacks the capacity to make choices that are inherently political morgan s powerfully argued case study should inspire much debate and inform forthcoming congressional deliberations over the renewal of the preclearance section of the vra in 2007
